One arts or science elective (a half-unit maximum) may be substituted for a professional elective with permission of the Department Chair. *Seek academic advising every year.* Check with your academic advisor if you are returning in mid-October from co-op, or if you wish to substitute a half-unit of Arts or Science elective with a professional elective. THMT 2201	Alternate Forms of Tourism. <i>Prerequisites: THMT 1101 or equivalent or permission of the instructor.</i>
THMT 2225	Design Management in Business and Tourism. <i>Prerequisites: THMT 1101, BUSI 1112 or permission of the instructor</i>
THMT/BUSI 3311	Small Business Management. <i>Prerequisite: BUSI 2222.</i>
BUSI 3314	Labour Relations. <i>Prerequisite: BUSI 2215.</i>
THMT 3317	Beverage Management. <i>Prerequisite: THMT 2216 or permission of the instructor.</i>
THMT 3323	Event & Meeting Management. <i>Prerequisite: THMT 1101 or permission of the instructor.</i>
THMT 3380	Study Tour. <i>Prerequisites: Permission of the department. Normally, completion of 15.0 units of university credit and enrolment in either the BTHM or Bachelor of Business Administration degree program is required.</i>
THMT 4405	Destination Planning. <i>Prerequisites: BUSI 2231 and THMT 1101 or permission of the instructor.</i>
THMT 4406	Destination Development. <i>Prerequisite: THMT 4405</i>
BUSI/WOMS 4406	Managing Diversity: Gender and Other Issues. <i>Prerequisite: at least 10.0 units of university-level courses.</i>
THMT/BUSI 4410	Small Business Consultancy. <i>Prerequisites: BUSI, 2214, 2215, 2231, and 3361.</i>
THMT 4411	Current Issues in Food, Beverage and Catering Management. <i>Prerequisite: THMT 2216.</i>
THMT 4421	Accommodation and Leisure Operations. <i>Prerequisite: Restricted to students who have completed 15.0 units in the tourism and hospitality management or the business administration degree programs.</i>
THMT 4444	Sustainable Tourism: A Global Perspective. <i>Prerequisite: THMT 2244</i>
THMT/BUSI 4446	New Venture Creation for Business and Tourism. <i>Prerequisites: BUSI 1112 or THMT 1101 and BUSI/THMT 3311 or permission of the instructor.</i>
THMT 4490/91	Directed Studies I or II. <i>Prerequisite: Permission of the department. Normally, completion of 15.0 units of university credit and enrolment in the Bachelor of Tourism and Hospitality Management degree program is required.</i>

Notes:

1. You may ONLY complete a practica-based BTHM if you meet ONE of the following criteria:
 - a. you had 7 ½ units of transfer credit when you were admitted to the BTHM degree program.
 - b. you have TWO full years of work experience in the tourism or hospitality fields.
 - c. you are completing your degree on a part-time enrolment basis.
 - d. you are completing your degree on a distance education basis.

If you do not meet one of the criteria above, you are automatically in the Co-op program.
2. Students may complete a Concentration in French or Spanish as part of their BTHM program. Students can also complete a minor in another discipline. A minor requires the completion of three units of coursework in the field. Consult the Academic Calendar for more information about these options.
3. All of the electives shown are not offered every year. Students should carefully plan their electives and seek information from their academic advisor about the scheduling of elective courses.
